THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

150 Students were expelled from the Chicago Public Schools in January 2005

DESCRIPTION:

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 10-22.6 and 34-19 of the *School Code of Illinois*, Section 6-2 of the *Rules of the Board of Education of the City of Chicago*, and the *Uniform*

Discipline Code of the Chicago Public Schools, the Chief Education Officer approved the expulsion of 150 Chicago Public Schools students, for gross disobedience, misconduct or other violations of the bylaws, rules and regulations of the Chicago Board of Education.


