1. <u>General Requirements</u>. D. Exceptions

If for medical reasons one or more of the required immunizations must be given after October 15th (or the first

physician/clinic has provided the school with the schedule of dates for the administration of immunizations and a statement of the medical reason causing the delay. Such schedule and statement must be issued by the physician, advanced practice nurse, physician assistant, registered nurse or local health department that will be responsible for administration of the remaining required immunizations. A student who is scheduled to receive further immunizations but fails to comply with said schedule will receive a "Notice of Exclusion From School" signed by the principal excluding the student, and the student will remain out of school until proof of compliance with immunization requirements is presented.
