

AMEND BOARD REPORT 07-0523-ED18

APPROVE ENTERING INTO MASTER AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS UNIVERSITIES TO HAVE THEM PROVIDE STUDENT INTERNS IN THE AREAS OF SOCIAL WORK, SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY, PSYCHOLOGY, PHYSICAL THERAPY, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY AND NURSING

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into Master Agreements with various universities to have them provide student interns (interns) in one or more of the following areas depending upon the university's accreditation: Social Work

Speech-Language Pathology, Psychology, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Nursing. The types of Interns that a University may provide are specified in Exhibit A. Each Master Agreement shall contain a separate Scope of Services for each type of Intern that the University is authorized to provide. University Interns and services shall be provided without charge. Individual agreements with each University are currently being negotiated. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each University in the event a written agreement for such University is not executed within 90 days of the date of this amended Board Report. Information pertinent to these agreements is stated below.

This amended Board Report is necessary to do the following: make changes to the text to update titles

- **Social Work:** Ideally, Each Masters of Social Work (MSW) Intern shall provide a minimum of 600 hours of social work services to CPS students during their assigned school year; and Each ~~Each~~ Masters Intern shall provide a minimum of 250 hours of Social Work services to CPS

Social Work:

Each University shall assess and transmit to the CAC Field Instructors performance evaluations for that

Field Instructors shall receive at least two times per school year for schools on the semester

system, and at least three times per school year for schools on a trimester system

Conflicts - The agreements shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one- year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.


