PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: College Bridge and College Excel are programs designed to serve well-qualified and highly-motivated CPS high school juniors and seniors, and to encourage them to pursue a college education. The students are enrolled in the Chicago Public Schools and in one of approximately 200 courses available at participating colleges and universities. These courses are in the areas of behavioral/social sciences, science, English, foreign languages, math, computer science, applied science and fine arts. The students will receive both high school credit weighted equal to Advanced Placement courses, and




