

AUTHORIZE NEW AGREEMENT WITH ANN AND ROBERT H. LURIE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF CHICAGO FOR PROGRAM EVALUATION SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize a new agreement with Ann and Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago to provide evaluation services for the Carol M. White Physical Education Program ("PEP") grant to Office of Student Health and Wellness at a total cost not to exceed \$225,000.00. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis; the sole source request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement

Review Committee and approved by Chief Procurement Officer. A written agreement for Vendor's services is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by and no payment shall be made to Vendor prior to execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically repeal in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

The Board shall have the right to terminate this agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Ann and Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago will provide leadership on all evaluation efforts for the Healthy Chicago Public Schools initiative per the award under the Carol M. White Physical Education Program. The evaluation of the physical education program will include data collection, maintenance

analysis and reporting. Vendor will recruit schools to participate in the evaluation. Once schools agree to
