

AUTHORIZE A NEW AGREEMENT WITH FOX VALLEY FIRE AND SAFETY FOR INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF FIRE PUMPS AND SPRINKLER SYSTEMS

THE INTERIM CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize a new agreement with Fox Valley Fire and Safety Co to provide inspection, maintenance, and repair of fire pumps and sprinkler systems to the Department of Facilities at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. Vendors were selected on a competitive basis pursuant to

bid issued by the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA). Subsequently, the CTA and Vendor entered into a

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will provide fire prevention equipment maintenance including inspection, maintenance, and repair of fire pumps and sprinkler systems.

OUTCOMES:

Vendor's services will result in extended life of fire prevention equipment, centralized management of the services to increase efficiency and volume discounts with one vendor.

COMPENSATION:

Vendor shall be paid as follows as set forth in the agreement. Estimated annual costs for the three (3) year term are set forth below: \$1,050,000, in the aggregate for FY 16, 17 and 18.

None.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize the General Counsel to include other relevant terms and conditions in the written agreement.


