AUTHORIZE THE FIRST AND SECOND RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH FOLLETT SCHOOL SOLUTIONS, INC FOR STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM SOFTWARE, HOSTING, MAINTENANCE

AND SUPPORT SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the first and second renewal agreement with Follett School Solutions, Inc for Student Information System Software, Hosting, Maintenance and Support Services

The new SIS software from Follett, called Aspen, will replace four of the modular applications that comprise the Board's current student information system (IMPACT). Specifically, the solution will replace the current IMPACT modules supplied by NCS Pearson and Omicron Technologies. Targeted school based functionality includes registration and enrollment, demographics, grading, attendance, discipline, health

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:

Pursuant to the Remedial Program for Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Participation in Goods and Services contracts (M/WBE Program), this contract is exempt as this agreement is for proprietary software.
